

- A. Students will get total Cash reward disbursed in two equal installments(1st award installment by 15th June 2023 & 2nd reward installment by 15th November 2023.
- **B.** Cash reward shall be paid by cheque.
- **c.** *For Cash Reward: Student will have to qualify both rank and minimum qualifying parentage criteria if a student lies in two row of above table by different criteria than he/she will be getting lower cash reward.

- 1. Please read carefully all terms and conditions on backside of Registration form.
- 2. Incomplete form will not be considered. It is compulsory to fill all the columns. Kindly attach all the required documents along with duly filled-in Registration Form.
- 3. It is compulsory to provide mobile No. & E-mail ID of the student / parent / guardian. The result of tests or any other information by the MOMENTUM will be sent to the student via SMS and / or E-mail. MOMENTUM shall not be responsible if any information regarding result or anything else does not reach the student because of he/she has not mentioned his/her or Parents/Guardian updated & correct mobile No./ E-mail ID in MEPL Form at the time of Registration. It is advised to write Phone No.& E-mail ID of either father or mother for right communication between institute & student.
- 4. POLICY FOR AVAILING SCHOLARSHIP & REWARD: During the classroom/Hybrid Program at Momentum, a student must meet the following requirements failing which his/her Scholarship & Reward will be revoked with immediate effect. The decision of Chairman & Managing Director, MEPL shall be final and binding to all parties.
- (a) Attendance: The attendance of the student in the coaching class should not drop below 85% throughout Classroom / Hybrid program. It is compulsory for a student under this program to write all his/her class test papers conducted by the institute in his/her batch. If a student keeps himself/herself absent from the classes without prior permission from the centre Head, then a warning letter will be issued against him/her. Despite the warning letter, If the student continues to default further and does not change his/her attitude, then the Scholarship & Reward program of such student will be revoked with immediate effect. If a student continues to remain absent for more than two weeks due to health issues or any other reason without prior permission from the Centre Head, his/her candidature for the Scholarship & Rewards program will be revoked.
- (b) Test Score: The students will be required to maintain a minimum of 65% marks in their phase assessment tests (for Engineering Aspirants) and 60% (for Medical Aspirants). And a minimum of 40% marks in their Regular Assessment Tests on Fortnightly & Monthly basis to continue their scholarship award in Forthcoming Years of their 2/3/4 Year Program.
- (c) Indiscipline: Any act of indiscipline by the student brought to the notice of the administration of MEPL in the classroom centre will not be accepted. A warning will be issued to such students, offering them another chance to improve their behaviour. Despite warning, if the student does not alter than his/her candidature for the Scholarship & Reward will be revoked with immediate effect and can be struck off from roll. In case a student misbehaves / gets involed in negative activities like teasing, theft, indiscipline, use of abusive languages, he/she can be rusticated by the Centre Head and fee paid shall not be refunded in such cases.
- 5. DISPUTE: In case, any dispute arises between student/parents and the Institute regarding the interpretation of these terms and conditions, non-payment of any claim or any dispute arising out of or in pursuant to these terms and conditions, the same shall be referred to sole arbitrator who shall be appointed by the Managing Director of M/s. Momentum Eduserve Private Limited. The proceedings shall be conducted at Gorakhpur under the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act and the Courts at Gorakhpur only shall have the jurisdiction over the matter and/or for enforcement as the case may be. Arbitrator to whom the matter is referred refuses to act or for any reason, does not enter the reference or after entering into the reference proceedings are abandoned or kept in abeyance or not proceeded with, it shall be lawful for the Managing Director of M/s. Momentum Eduserve Private Limited to appoint another person to act as and arbitrator in the manner aforesaid. Such person shall be entitled to proceed with reference from the stage at which proceeding was left by his predecessor, if both the parties consent to this effect, failing which the new arbitrator will be entitled to proceed denovo.
